The annual Ocean Surface Topography Science Team (OST-ST) meeting will be held this year in Lisbon, Portugal from 18 – 20 October, 2010. This meeting will focus on the analysis of the OSTM/Jason-2 mission post-validation phase, in comparison with the tandem Jason-1 mission data, and will include CalVal results and in-orbit mission performance assessment. On-going activities on current and future altimetric projects will also be presented and discussed.

Structure of the meeting – As usual, the OST-ST meeting will include splinter working sessions, a poster session and two half-day plenary sessions. A complete agenda will be prepared and circulated at a later stage by the OST-ST chairs (H. Bonekamp, L.L. Fu, J. Lambin, J. Lillibridge, R. Morrow and J. Willis) according to the solicited contributions from the OST-ST Principal Investigators and Co-Investigators.
